How was 2021?

The organization's work focused on addressing the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, including digital violence, environmental pollution, challenges in social inclusion and public health, the conservation of vulnerable species, and environmental research.

Research:

- Jaboque Wetland in Crisis
- Conservation measures driven by community leadership to protect *Talauma hernandezii* and *Henicorhina negreti* in Colombia's Coffee Region.
- Environmental crimes in high-mountain ecosystems: Assessment of criminal impacts on the threatened species *Espeletiopsis purpurascens* in Colombian-Venezuelan páramo environments.

Impacts:

During the first year of legal existence, proposals woven from the community in the spaces were realized, reaching dozens of families in vulnerable conditions across different territories, survivors of the violence and exclusions of the COVID-19 lockdown, among them:

- 400 victims of the armed conflict
- 200 Children, Adolescents, and Youth - CAY
- 100 Refugees, Migrants, and Returnees
- 75 Women heads of households
- 350 Environmental leaders
- 85 Public officials

Main results:

- Creation of the Families for Rights Committee in Soacha, Cundinamarca for the prevention of sexual exploitation of CAY
- Socio-environmental Diagnosis presented to the UNDP focusing on the municipalities of Soacha, La Cabrera, and Sibaté
- Participation in the Environmental Volunteer Network of the CAR Cundinamarca
- Environmental Notification in the Epidemiological Surveillance Network of the northern, southern, and western zones of Bogotá with the support of the District Health Secretariat
- Generation of communicative products in preventive health, human rights, sustainable development, and inclusion
- Development of climate change adaptation programs
