## How did 2023 unfold?

During 2023, our Latin American region was impacted by a cyberattack directed at operations in Colombia, temporarily disrupting access to organizational services. Once services were restored and the incident investigated, the organization continued its efforts with trust, transparency, and care for its audiences.

## **Impacts:**

During 2023, we executed initiatives in capacity strengthening, technological development, applied research, and digital skills transfer, alongside other direct support actions for communities. These efforts reached:

- 50 victims of armed conflict
- 322 environmental science university students
- 48 LGBTIQ+ individuals
- 92 youth aged 18 to 28
- 130 refugee, migrant, and returning women
- 175 environmental leaders
- 54 Afro-descendant leaders
- 41 Indigenous leaders
- 60 leaders from social groups
- 110 social organizations
- 20 public-sector officials
- 30 leaders from organizations in other LATAM countries

## **Key Outcomes:**

- Development of the #RedInternetLibre advocacy initiative promoting universal internet access without distinction of nationality or origin, with backing from human rights authorities.
- Restoration of web services damaged by a ransomware attack.
- Participation in two internet governance events on data protection and digital inclusion for diverse youth and women.
- Presentation of the research report “Gaps and Violence” in San José, Costa Rica.


