



How Did 2024 Unfold?

The year 2024 set important benchmarks for the organization's work, with new initiatives across Colombia and Venezuela (through its Section for Venezuelan Affairs and Projects), international travel, and strategic research for Colombia and the region.

Impacts:

In 2024, we boosted efforts in monitoring, tech innovation, research, education, and digital skill transfer, along with a range of direct community support actions, reaching:

- 163 LGBTIQ+ community members
- 57 youth aged 18–28
- 300 environmental leaders
- 120 Afro-descendant leaders
- 60 Indigenous leaders
- 85 leaders from social organizations
- 53 leaders from organizations across LATAM
- 20 representatives from partner donors

Key Achievements:

- Stronger strategy for marine-related advocacy and civic participation.
- Participation in the Third Youth Internet Governance Forum of Colombia (YOUTHIGF Colombia 2024).
- Participation in the 2024 Latin America and Caribbean Youth Internet Governance Forum.
- Environmental and human rights studies published and shared across national and regional advocacy spaces.



