How did 2025 unfold?

In 2025, the organization strengthened its national and regional response, engaging more local voices in its actions and addressing the socioeconomic and environmental threats that disproportionately impact historically excluded communities.

Impacts:

During 2025, monitoring, technical reinforcement, research, and technological skill transfer activities were carried out to directly support communities. These actions reached:

- 240 environmental leaders
- 99 Afro-descendant leaders
- 180 Indigenous leaders
- 77 LGBTIQ+ individuals
- 160 social organization leaders
- 83 public officials
- 40 older adults over 60
- 70 rural community groups
- 45 youth leaders aged 15 to 24

Main Results:

- An intercultural civic space roundtable launched with human rights guarantor authorities, public sector entities, academia, and civil society.
- Publication of the 2024 Civic Space Monitoring Report and the 2025 update.
- Training on the Escazú Agreement for more than 240 environmental leaders across 10 regions of Colombia.
- Strengthening of 65 Afro and Indigenous organizations through digital inclusion resources.
- Three sustainability and renewable energy studies supported by academic partners.
- New participation and environmental conservation methodologies tailored to coastal and strategic ecosystem communities.
